**For EMERGENCY always call 999**

**for NON-URGENT matters REPORT ONLINE**

Do this through the Sussex Police website [www.sussex.police.uk](http://www.sussex.police.uk)  
when you don't need to talk but want to tell us about something.

**OR call 101**

when you need to talk to someone but don't require an urgent response.

If you are deaf, hard of hearing, or speech impaired, you can use

**TypeTalk on 18000 or send a text to 65999**
